#### 1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the "Veterans Education3 Transparency Act".

### 4 SEC. 2. AVAILABILITY OF DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AF-

5 FAIRS RECORDS TO EDUCATIONAL INSTITU-6 TIONS IN WHICH VETERANS OR PERSONS RE-7 CEIVING EDUCATIONAL ASSISTANCE UNDER 8 THE LAWS ADMINISTERED BY THE SEC-9 RETARY OF VETERANS AFFAIRS ARE EN-10 ROLLED.

(a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 36 of
title 38, United States Code, is amended by adding at the
end the following new section:

# 14 "§ 3699. Availability of records to educational institu15 tions

16 "The Secretary shall provide to any veteran or person who receives educational assistance under the laws admin-17 istered by the Secretary the option of making the veteran's 18 19 or person's relevant records maintained by the Secretary, 20including information about the amount of educational as-21 sistance to which the veteran or person is entitled, avail-22 able through an Internet website to the educational insti-23 tution that provides the course of education in which the 24 veteran or person is enrolled. The Secretary shall take such steps as may be necessary to ensure that— 25

"(1) an educational institution to which such
records are made available enters into an agreement
with the Secretary under which the institution
agrees that such records will only made available for
the purpose of counseling the veteran or person in
making decisions related to the veteran's or person's
education; and

8 "(2) no unauthorized person is given access to 9 any record made available to an educational institu-10 tion under this section, including by requiring the 11 use of passwords and other appropriate mechanisms 12 for restricting access to the records by unauthorized 13 persons.".

(b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sections
at the beginning of such chapter is amended by adding
at the end of the items relating to such subchapter the
following new item:

"3699. Availability of records to educational institutions.".
