1 SEC. 2. UNITED STATES AMBASSADOR AT LARGE FOR ARC-2 TIC AFFAIRS. 3 Title I of the State Department Basic Authorities Act

of 1956 (22 U.S.C. 2651a et seq.) is amended by adding 4 5 at the end the following new section:

6 "SEC. 63. UNITED STATES AMBASSADOR AT LARGE FOR 7 **ARCTIC AFFAIRS.**

"(a) ESTABLISHMENT.—There is established within 8 the Department of State an Ambassador at Large for Arc-9 10 tic Affairs (referred to in this section as the 'Ambassador'), appointed in accordance with subsection (b). 11

12 "(b) APPOINTMENT.—The Ambassador shall be appointed by the President, by and with the advice and con-13 sent of the Senate. 14

15 "(c) DUTIES.—

16

"(1) DIPLOMATIC REPRESENTATION.—Subject 17 to the direction of the President and the Secretary 18 of State, the Ambassador is authorized to represent 19 the United States in matters and cases relevant to 20 Arctic affairs in—

21 "(A) contacts with foreign governments, 22 intergovernmental organizations, and special-23 ized agencies of the United Nations, the Arctic 24 Council, and other international organizations 25 of which the United States is a member; and

"(B) multilateral conferences and meetings
 relating to Arctic affairs.

3 "(2) CHAIR OF THE ARCTIC COUNCIL.—The
4 Ambassador shall serve as the Chair of the Arctic
5 Council when the United States holds the Chairman6 ship of the Arctic Council from 2015 through 2017.
7 "(3) POLICIES AND PROCEDURES.—The Am8 bassador shall coordinate United States Arctic poli9 cies.".
