2	This Act may be cited as the "America Votes Act of

4	SEC. 2. PERMITTING USE OF SWORN WRITTEN STATEMENT
5	TO MEET IDENTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS
6	FOR VOTING.
7	(a) Permitting Use of Statement.—Title III of
8	the Help America Vote Act of 2002 (52 U.S.C. 21081 et
9	seq.) is amended by inserting after section 303 the fol-
10	lowing new section:
11	"SEC. 303A. PERMITTING USE OF SWORN WRITTEN STATE-

14	"(a) Use of Statement.—
15	"(1) In general.—Except as provided in sub-
