1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the "America Votes Act of3 2023".

4 SEC. 2. PERMITTING USE OF SWORN WRITTEN STATEMENT
5 TO MEET IDENTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS
6 FOR VOTING.

7 (a) PERMITTING USE OF STATEMENT.—Title III of
8 the Help America Vote Act of 2002 (52 U.S.C. 21081 et
9 seq.) is amended by inserting after section 303 the fol10 lowing new section:

11"SEC. 303A. PERMITTING USE OF SWORN WRITTEN STATE-12MENT TO MEET IDENTIFICATION REQUIRE-

13 MENTS.

14 "(a) USE OF STATEMENT.—

15 "(1) IN GENERAL.—Except as provided in sub-16 section (c), if a State has in effect a requirement 17 that an individual present identification as a condi-18 tion of receiving and casting a ballot in an election 19 for Federal office, the State shall permit the indi-20 vidual to meet the requirement—

21 "(A) in the case of an individual who de22 sires to vote in person, by presenting the appro23 priate State or local election official with a
24 sworn written statement, signed by the indi25 vidual under penalty of perjury, attesting to the
26 individual's identification and attesting that the

1	individual is registered to vote in the election;
2	or
3	"(B) in the case of an individual who de-
4	sires to vote by mail, by submitting with the
5	ballot the statement described in subparagraph
6	(A).
7	"(2) Providing pre-printed copy of state-
8	MENT.—A State which is subject to paragraph (1)
9	shall—
10	"(A) prepare a pre-printed version of the
11	statement described in paragraph $(1)(A)$ which
12	includes a blank space for an individual to pro-
13	vide a name and signature;
14	"(B) make copies of the pre-printed
15	version available at polling places for election
16	officials to distribute to individuals who desire
17	to vote in person; and
18	"(C) include a copy of the pre-printed
19	version with each blank absentee or other ballot
20	transmitted to an individual who desires to vote
21	by mail.
22	"(b) Requiring Use of Regular Ballot.—A
23	State may not require an individual who presents or sub-
24	mits a sworn written statement in accordance with sub-

section (a)(1) to cast a provisional ballot in the election
 under section 302.

3 "(c) EXCEPTION FOR FIRST-TIME VOTERS REG4 ISTERING BY MAIL.—Subsections (a) and (b) do not apply
5 with respect to any individual described in paragraph (1)
6 of section 303(b) who is required to meet the requirements
7 of paragraph (2) of such section.".

8 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENT RELATING TO EN9 FORCEMENT.—Section 401 of such Act (52 U.S.C. 21111)
10 is amended by striking "and 303" and inserting "303, and
11 303A".

(c) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of contents
of such Act is amended by inserting after the item relating
to section 303 the following new item:

"Sec. 303A. Permitting use of sworn written statement to meet identification requirements.".

15 SEC. 3. REQUIRING STATES TO INCLUDE INFORMATION ON
16 USE OF SWORN WRITTEN STATEMENT IN
17 VOTING INFORMATION MATERIAL POSTED AT
18 POLLING PLACES.
19 Section 302(b)(2) of the Help America Vote Act of
20 2002 (52 U.S.C. 21082(b)(2)) is amended—

21 (1) by striking "and" at the end of subpara22 graph (E);

23 (2) by striking the period at the end of sub24 paragraph (F) and inserting "; and"; and

(3) by adding at the end the following new sub paragraph:

3 "(G) in the case of a State that has in ef4 fect a requirement that an individual present
5 identification as a condition of receiving and
6 casting a ballot in an election for Federal office,
7 information on how an individual may meet
8 such requirement by presenting a sworn written
9 statement in accordance with section 303A.".

10 SEC. 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.

11 The amendments made by this Act shall apply with12 respect to elections occurring on or after the date of the13 enactment of this Act.
