I am requesting funding for the Everson Dual-Use Emergency Shelter & Response Center project in Fiscal Year 2027. The funding would be used to develop a dual-use emergency facility that will function as a disaster shelter, an emergency supply coordination hub and a meeting and operations space during floods and other emergencies.
