1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the "National Evaluation
3 of Aviation and Aerospace Solutions to Climate Change
4 Act of 2020".

5 SEC. 2. STUDY ON CERTAIN CLIMATE CHANGE MITIGATION 6 EFFORTS.

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 90 days after the 8 date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Transpor-9 tation shall seek to enter into an agreement with the Na-10 tional Academies of Sciences, Engineering, and Medicine 11 (referred to in this Act as the "National Academies") to 12 conduct a study on climate change mitigation efforts with 13 respect to the civil aviation and aerospace industries.

14 (b) STUDY CONTENTS.—In conducting the study15 under subsection (a), the National Academies shall—

16 (1) identify climate change mitigation efforts,
17 including efforts relating to emerging technologies,
18 in the civil aviation and aerospace industries;

(2) develop and apply an appropriate indicatorfor assessing the effectiveness of such efforts;

(3) identify gaps in such efforts;

(4) identify barriers preventing expansion ofsuch efforts; and

1 (1) FINDINGS OF STUDY.—Not later than 1 2 year after the date on which the Secretary enters 3 into an agreement for a study pursuant to sub-4 section (a), the Secretary shall submit to the appro-5 priate congressional committees the findings of the 6 study.

7 (2) ASSESSMENT.—Not later than 180 days
8 after the date on which the Secretary submits the
9 findings pursuant to paragraph (1), the Secretary,
10 acting through the Administrator of the Federal
11 Aviation Administration, shall submit to the appro12 priate congressional committees a report that con13 tains an assessment of the findings.

(d) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There is
authorized to be appropriated to the Secretary to carry
out this section \$1,500,000.

17 (e) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

(1) APPROPRIATE CONGRESSIONAL COMMITTEES.—The term "appropriate congressional committees" means the Committee on Transportation
and Infrastructure of the House of Representatives,
the Committee on Commerce, Science, and Transportation of the Senate, and other congressional
committees determined appropriate by the Secretary.

(2) CLIMATE CHANGE MITIGATION EFFORTS.—
 The term "climate change mitigation efforts" means
 efforts, including the use of technologies, materials,
 processes, or practices, that contribute to the reduc tion of greenhouse gas emissions.
