I am requesting funding for the Concrete Sauk Valley Road Bank Stabilization (MP 3.7) project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is Skagit County, located at 1800 Continental Place, Mount Vernon, WA 98273. The funding would be used to repair an eroding riverbank that supports Concrete Sauk Valley Road in eastern Skagit County. This project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will ensure that the road remains open, avoiding a 32-mile detour that would delay the reliable movement of freight, add costs for businesses and motorists and significantly harm the response time of emergency services.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 23 USC 133.
