1 SEC. 2. LOCAL RAIL FACILITIES AND SAFETY.

- 2 (a) In General.—Chapter 201 of title 49, United
- 3 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol-
- 4 lowing:

5 "§ 20168. Local rail facilities and safety program

- 6 "(a) Establishment.—The Secretary of Transpor-
- 7 tation, acting through the Administrator of the Federal
- 8 Railroad Administration, shall establish a local rail facili-
- 9 ties and safety program (in this section referred to as the
- 10 'Program') to mitigate the impacts of railroad operations
- 11 in local communities through improvements to highway-
- 12 rail grade crossings, rail line relocation and improvement
- 13 projects, and training and technical assistance to local
- 14 governments.
- 15 "(b) Grant Authority.—In carrying out the Pro-
- 16 gram, the Secretary may award grants to eligible entities
- 17 for freight capacity projects (as described under sub-
- 18 section (e)).
- 19 "(c) Application.—To be eligible for a grant under
- 20 the Program, an eligible entity shall submit to the Sec-
- 21 retary an application in such form, at such time, and con-
- 22 taining such information as the Secretary determines is
- 23 appropriate.
- 24 "(d) Project Selection Criteria.—In selecting
- 25 the recipients of grants for freight capacity projects under
- 26 the Program, the Secretary shall consider—

1	"(1) the extent to which a proposed project—
2	"(A) alleviates the impacts of rail oper-
3	ations on local neighborhoods or urbanized
4	areas;
5	"(B) will result in clearly-defined public
6	benefits;
7	"(C) contributes to increasing the competi-
8	tiveness and state of good repair of short line
9	railroads;
10	"(D) enhances safety at critical highway-
11	rail grade crossings;
12	"(E) is compatible with local land use, eco-
13	nomic development, and transportation plans
14	and objectives;
15	"(F) includes equitable participation from
16	other beneficiaries in the project's financing, in-
17	cluding the extent to which the project will le-
18	verage private or local government investments;
19	and
20	"(G) will increase the reliability and resil-
21	ience of the nation's freight system; and
22	"(2) the past performance of the recipient and
23	other beneficiaries of the project in developing and
24	delivering rail projects.

1	"(e) Freight Capacity Projects.—A grant
2	awarded under the Program may be used for the following:
3	"(1) A capital project to mitigate the impacts
4	of rail infrastructure and operations on a local com-
5	munity, including—
6	"(A) rail line relocation and improvement;
7	and
8	"(B) improving the safety of, or elimi-
9	nating hazards at, a highway-rail grade cross-
10	ing.
11	"(2) A capital project to improve short-line rail-
12	road infrastructure.
13	"(3) Training and technical assistance to help
14	local governments better understand how to coordi-
15	nate with railroad carriers on—
16	"(A) operations and safety issues; and
17	"(B) how to integrate railroad issues into
18	land use and transportation planning processes.
19	"(f) USE OF FUNDS.—A grant may be used to pay
20	all or a portion of the subsidy and administrative costs
21	of projects eligible for Federal credit assistance under the
22	Railroad Revitalization and Regulatory Reform Act of
23	1976 (45 U.S.C. 801 et seq.) for a capital project to im-
24	prove short-line railroad infrastructure.

 2 the term 'eligible entity' means each of the following:

 "(1) One on more States
