

LARSEN HOLDS DATA CENTERS **ACCOUNTABLE**



I am working in Congress to put guardrails on data centers.

I support tough, upfront restrictions:

- No high electric bills for local families and small businesses;
- No federal tax breaks;
- No construction without community approval and union labor;
- Data centers must pay their fair share to connect to and use the grid; and
- Data centers must use closed loop water systems.

My Work in Congress		
<i>Ratepayer Protection Act</i>	Requires state regulators to consider directing data centers to pay the full cost of connection to the grid	Passed the House
<i>Big Ugly Tax Breaks for Data Centers Act</i>	Rolls back tax breaks for large AI data centers in Republicans' Big Ugly Law	Introduced

These bills are only a start, and there is a lot more work to do.

Skagit County and Snohomish County have recently enacted temporary data center moratoriums. **I support the ability of local jurisdictions to give themselves time to decide how they want to manage large data centers.**

I will keep working to understand how our communities could be impacted by the growth of data centers in the PNW.
